Notice of Race

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY Olympiacos S.F.P

2. RULES

The regatta will be governed by :

- The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (World sailing).
- The Class rules (unless otherwise modified by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions).
- This Notice of Race.
- The Sailing Instructions.
- All competitors shall be required to wear an adequate personal floatation device at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.
- If there is a conflict between languages the English text shall take precedence.

3. ADVERTISING

The ISAF Advertising Regulation 20 shall apply.

Boats may be required to display a bow number and advertisement of the event sponsor on either side on the forward 25% of the hull.

Sailboards may be required to display such number and advertising on either side of the sail above the wishbone.

Boats authorized to have advertising must present the permission of their National Authority.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

4.1 This regatta is open for the Olympic class: **Heavyweight Dinghy: Finn**

Competitors and Team Leaders shall complete registration forms at the Registration Office in front of the boat parking area on **Monday Dec 11th at 10:00 to 11:00.**

Sailing Instructions will be available at the registration desk.

5. SAIL NUMBERS

Boats shall use the approved Nationality Code Letters on their sails as required by Appendix G. Competitors may be required to wear bibs (which will be provided by Organizing Authority). In alteration of their Class Rules, the national letters and boat numbers on the sails shall apply for all classes according to RRS G1.1.

6. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions.

On the water, a boat can be instructed by a race committee Equipment Inspector/Measurer to proceed immediately to a designated area for inspection.

7. SCORING SYSTEM

The Low - Point Scoring System will apply.

8. INSURANCE

Competitors will participate to the Regatta entirely at their own risk.

The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for personal or material damage, injury or death, sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the Regatta

The Organizing Authority disclaims any and all such liability.

For each competing yacht at least a valid third party liability insurance not less than **540.000 Euros** shall be in existence for the entire duration of the Regatta.

It shall be the sole responsibility of the competitor to have such insurance cover and provide written proof thereof to the Organizing Authority upon request.

Third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of **540.000 Euros**, must be presented at the registration desk (the original issued by the insurance company).

9. RACING FORMAT

Course will be posted to the notice board at the Registration Office in front of the boat parking area on **Monday** Dec 11th at 10:00 **to 11:00**.
